

REQUIREMENTS FOR FFA CHORD:

In order to be considered for graduation chords, students must achieve ___ 5 ___ of the following by the time they prepare for graduation:

1. Must be a paid active FFA member for all 4 years.
2. Must be good standing in conduct and academics for all 4 years (NO out of class/school placement- No ISS, No OSS, and No Guidance also have at LEAST a 3.0 GPA)
3. Must have placed top 5 place at Houston Livestock Show & Rodeo or any other major show in state (State Fair, Fort Worth, San Antonio, Austin, *may also include showmanship award or making auction).
4. Must have placed top 3 place overall at Pasadena Livestock Show & Rodeo *may also include any showmanship award
5. Must have received a recognition award or scholarship (above the chapter level.)
 1. examples: Lone Star degree, TJLA, Proficiency, Ford Scholar, District, Area, or State officer
6. Must have completed at least ___ 50 ___ hours of documented volunteer/community service while representing FFA
7. Must have attended State and/or National conventions.
8. Must be an elected and active officer for no less than 3 years. Active officer includes : participated in events such as Parades, Fundraisers, Socials, Convention Voting, Speaking at banquet, Attend all chapter meetings etc..)
9. Must have participated and awarded in any of the following : CDE's, LDE's, SDE's
